

Hi Beanstalks!

If you want to print out the Bean Pod* to look like a book:

1. Print out the pages. (You might check the “reverse order” box when you print so the end product is a pile of spreads in the right order, with the cover on top, and the Calendar page right under it.) Otherwise you’ll have to put the pages in order yourself.

2. Then take the cover page, place it face down on the table and put the stack (with the Calendar page being on top) on top of the faced-down cover page.

3. Staple in the corner, and fold in half like a booklet, and you’ll have the closest thing you can get to a booklet without using a saddle stitcher!

*If you want to save your color ink, you can print it in black and white.



Meanwhile, you can explore the contents of the other buttons on the web site home page. Once you have access to Membership Services, you will be able to read current and past editions of *The Bean Pod*, other tall club newsletters, and TCI's *ExecuTALLk* newsletter. You'll find many other services including a chat room, TCI business information, and even member obituaries.

The TCI Weekends web site – This is where you can find weekend and week-long parties hosted by tall clubs throughout North America. Log into <http://www.tciweekends.com>. You can access a weekend calendar, view fliers, and even register for some weekends online.

The Bean Pod monthly email – As a BBTC member, you receive notification of availability of the current BBTC newsletter online. Print out *The Bean Pod*, or save the link for access to the newsletter. From Boston via the Pike: Take Mass. Pike/I-90 West to **Exit 13**. Bear **RIGHT** off exit, following Rt. 30W. Go approx. 1/2 mile, past Shopper's World & Target Plaza, & take a **RIGHT** at light onto CONCORD ST (aka Rt. 126 N). Follow Concord Street a couple of miles. (NOTE: From here you're following Concord St., NOT Rt. 126, which eventually branches off.) Take your 1st **IMMEDIATE RIGHT** onto Water St (at the light). **Follow Water St. for approx. 1.5 miles** -- past a church on the left and Gerard's Farm/Kitchen on your right. Then take the next **LEFT** onto **PAMELA RD**. Our house is the brick house at the top of Pamela Rd., intersecting at 2 Spring Lane.

From Points West &/or 495: Take the Pike **EAST** to **Exit 12 (Rt 9)**. Follow **9East** for 2 miles to the Exit for "EDGE L L RD/Main St." Go straight up the Edgell Rd. exit ramp to the light, and take a **LEFT** at light (with a Plaza on the right & Gulf gas station on the left). Take a **RIGHT** at the light onto **WATER ST**. Follow **WATER ST**. for 1/2 mile to **SPRING LANE**. **SPRING LANE** is on your **RIGHT**, **the street's a little set back so pay attention!** #2 Spring Lane is a brickfront house at the top of the hill on the right. Park in the driveway or anywhere on the street.





